<p>To assemble, organize, preserve, socialize, and serve all expressed thought embodied as manuscripts, books, periodicals, their constituents' documents, and other similar documents produced as means of communication</p>	<p>To help in the contemporary development of knowledge, intentional and unintentional</p>	<p>To collect together all available recorded information particularly in the form of reference books, to socialize and serve freely all such information to each according to his needs at the moment</p>
<p>To help transmission of knowledge of the earlier generations to later ones</p>	<p>To conserve the research time of humanity by the separation of literature search from positive search</p>	<p>To increase the economic resources of humanity to the extent necessary to maintain the ever-increasing population, in comfort and free from want of any kind</p>

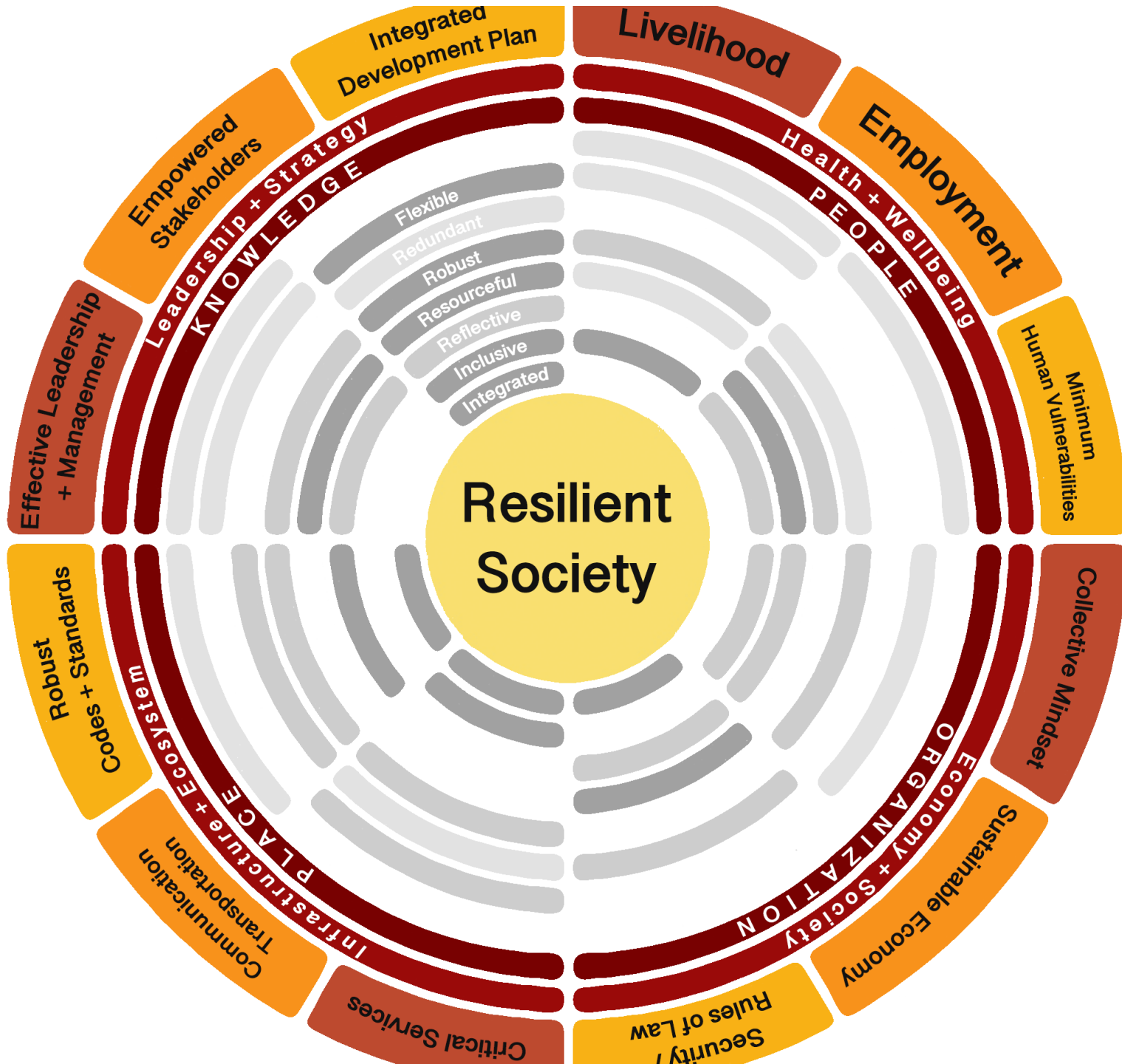
