A NEW FUNGUS FOR PUERTO RICO

Rhytisma leptospilum Berk. & Curt. is the tentative determination by Dr. W. W. Diehl of the immature stage of a fungus found on the tender leaf of "almendrón", *Prunus occidentalis*, at Villalba on August 2, 1954, as reported by John A. Stevenson, in charge, Section of Plant Disease Epidemics and Identification Section, Horticultural Crops Research Branch, ARS, USDA, Beltsville, Md. He writes that "the specimen is very interesting, but unfortunately is immature."
