LEPTOPHARSA CONSTRICTA (CHAMPION) A NEW LACEWING BUG (TINGIDAE:HEMIPTERA) FOR PUERTO RICO

A new lacewing bug not previously reported from Puerto Rico was discovered by the author during a visit to Cambalache Forest near Arecibo, P.R., in August 1961. Specimens of this lacewing bug were collected on the leaves of the leguminous vine, *Dolichos minimus* (L.) Medic. Intense chlorotic and yellowish areas were noted on the leaves of the vine infested

with this insect. Specimens submitted to the U.S. National Museum were identified by R. C. Froeschner as Leptopharsa constricta (Champion).
